Cookie Policy

What This Policy Covers

This Cookie Policy explains how Excavaite Inc. uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on our website (excavaite.com) and within Excavaite Cloud. It tells you what cookies we use, why we use them, and how you can control them.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website or use a web application. They allow the site or application to recognise your device, remember your preferences, and collect information about how you use the service. We also use similar technologies including local storage and session storage. For simplicity, we refer to all of these as “cookies” in this policy.

2. Where We Use Cookies

2.1 Excavaite Website (excavaite.com)

Our marketing and informational website uses cookies for functional purposes and analytics, and where you have consented, for marketing. A cookie consent banner will be presented on your first visit, giving you control over non-essential cookies.

2.2 Excavaite Cloud Application

The Excavaite Cloud application uses strictly necessary and functional cookies only. These are required to operate the application and cannot be disabled. The application does not use advertising or tracking cookies.

2.3 Excavaite Private

Excavaite Private is deployed within your own infrastructure. Excavaite does not place cookies in Excavaite Private. Any cookies used in your deployment are governed by your organisation’s own policies.

3. Categories of Cookies We Use

3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are required for the website and application to function. They cannot be disabled and do not collect personal information for marketing purposes.

excv_csrf	Excavaite	Cross-site request forgery protection token. Required for form submissions and state-changing actions.	Session
excv_idp_state	Excavaite	SSO state parameter used during SAML/OIDC authentication flow to prevent replay attacks.	5 minutes
cookieconsent_statuses	Excavaite	Stores your cookie consent preference so the banner is not shown on every page visit.	12 months

3.2 Functional Cookies

These cookies remember your preferences and settings to improve your experience. You can disable functional cookies, but some features may not work as expected.

Cookie Name	Provider	Purpose	Retention
excv_ui_prefs	Excavaite	Stores UI preferences such as sidebar state, table column widths, and display settings.	6 months
excv_lang	Excavaite	Stores your language and locale preference.	12 months
excv_tz	Excavaite	Stores your timezone setting for displaying dates and times correctly.	12 months

3.3 Analytics Cookies (Website Only)

We use analytics cookies on excavaite.com to understand how visitors use our website. Analytics data is collected in aggregate and does not identify individual visitors. These cookies require your consent and are not used in the Excavaite Cloud application.

_ga	Google Analytics	Distinguishes unique website visitors for aggregate traffic analysis.	2 years

ga[MEASUREMENT-ID]	Google Analytics	Maintains session state for Google Analytics 4.	2 years
_gid	Google Analytics	Distinguishes users across sessions for daily aggregate analysis.	24 hours

We use Google Analytics with IP anonymisation enabled. Analytics data is not shared with third parties for advertising purposes.

3.4 Cookies We Do NOT Use

Excavaite does not use advertising or retargeting cookies, cross-site tracking cookies, social media tracking pixels, or fingerprinting technologies on our website or in our application.

4. Third-Party Cookies

The only third-party cookies we use are Google Analytics cookies (described in Section 3.3), which are placed on excavaite.com only with your consent. We do not embed third-party widgets, social media buttons, or advertising networks that place additional cookies.

5. Managing Your Cookie Preferences

5.1 Cookie Consent Banner

When you first visit excavaite.com, a cookie consent banner will allow you to accept or decline non-essential cookies. You can change your preference at any time using the “Cookie Preferences” link in the website footer.

5.2 Browser Controls

All modern browsers allow you to control cookies through browser settings. You can block all cookies, block third-party cookies only, delete existing cookies, or be notified when a cookie is placed. Browser-specific instructions:

- Google Chrome: Settings > Privacy and Security > Cookies and other site data
- Mozilla Firefox: Settings > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data
- Apple Safari: Preferences > Privacy > Manage Website Data
- Microsoft Edge: Settings > Cookies and site permissions

5.3 Opt Out of Google Analytics

You can opt out of Google Analytics across all websites using the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on, available at tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout.

6. Do Not Track

Some browsers send a “Do Not Track” (DNT) signal. Excavaite’s website and application currently do not respond differently to DNT signals, as there is no industry-wide standard for how to do so. We rely on our cookie consent mechanism to respect your preferences.

7. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Cookie Policy when we introduce new features, change analytics providers, or in response to legal requirements. Material changes will be noted in the cookie consent banner. The current version is always available at excavaite.com/legal.
